What is IHE (Integrating the Healthcare Enterprise)?

IHE is an initiative by healthcare professionals and industry to improve the way computer systems in healthcare share information. Sponsored by the Healthcare Information and Management Systems Society (HIMSS), the Radiological Society of North America (RSNA), and the American College of Cardiology (ACC), IHE promotes the coordinated use of established standards such as DICOM and HL7 to address specific clinical needs in support of optimal patient care. IHE brings together the major vendors of healthcare imaging and information systems to agree upon and demonstrate standard interfaces and data architectures, advancing the state of data integration among their systems.
